



## Remote Teaching Guidance

In the event of a lockdown, we will immediately implement remote teaching via Microsoft Teams. What can you expect to see as part of your child's remote education?

- All children will be provided with computer access.
- All children will be taught/refreshed how to log onto their Teams account.
- Each day, children from all year groups will be provided with live lessons from their teacher that they should be supported to log into from home.
- Teachers will be able to share their screens in order to provide frequent, clear explanations of new content.
- Tasks will be set that continue to follow the curriculum of the year group and will cover a broad range of subjects.
- Children will be provided with their Power Maths books so that their lessons can continue.
- Whilst on calls, children must mute their microphones.
- The chat function should only be used for work-related discussion.
- Children, parents and staff should follow the school rules of 'Ready, Respectful and Safe' whilst communicating virtually / being part of a live lesson.
- Children should upload their completed work to Teams so that feedback can be given.
- Where clarification of work, additional support or emotional support is required, individual or small group calls will be set up in the afternoon where children will have further access to the staff.
- Children should have a balance of on-screen and off-screen time which should be managed by parents.
- Parents should monitor children's use of social media, you-tube and gaming to ensure E-Safety for children whilst they are working from home.
